QUALIFYING STANDARDS

The aim of the Mayfield One Day Event is to introduce school children to the sport of Eventing in preparation for them to compete in British Eventing Competitions

The x.c courses are constructed by a B.E.Coursebuilder, are solid and are well up to height. There are time wasting alternatives on the more difficult fences.

IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE TEAM MANAGER OF EACH TEAM TO ENSURE THAT ALL COMPETITORS ARE CAPABLE OF COMPETING AT THE LEVEL WHICH THEY ARE ENTERED FOR.

INDIVIDUAL ENTRIES – A PARENT MAY ASSUME THE ROLE OF TEAM MANAGER FOR THEIR CHILD.

ALL COMPETITORS MUST WEAR A MEDICAL ARMBAND FOR X.C. THESE MAY BE PURCHASED ON THE DAY

ENTRIES

1. If a competitor is aged 17 years or under, the entry form must be signed by a parent/guardian or person in loco parentis. Your signature on the entry form shall be deemed to be an acceptance of the Rules & Conditions herein.
2. Entry Fee £35 per person, including First Aid cover. Late entries £5 per person extra.
3. Cheques made payable to 'St. Leonards-Mayfield School'
4. Each entry form must be signed by the parents of competitors.

Rules & conditions of entry

5. This event will run under **British Eventing Rules 2010**.
6. When mounted, all riders must wear hats that meet the requirements of the current Rules.
7. No parent / trainer may ride the horse. Horses may only be ridden by the competitor. Horses may be lunged in appropriate areas.
8. Competitors must, on 1st Jan 2010, have been in full time education at the school they represent and, on the day of competition and the school be member of the NSEA.
9. Teams to consist of 3 or 4 riders, best 3 scores to count.
10. Individual entries will be accepted. All team competitors will also be eligible for individual placings.
11. No horse may compete more than once. No rider may compete in the same team twice.
12. The Organisers reserve the right to alter any of the rules as they see fit, or to cancel the event if necessary. In the event of cancellation, entry fees shall be refunded less £5 per entry, on receipt of an s.a.e.
13. In the case of a withdrawal, the entry fee will only be refunded on production of a Dr's or Vet's certificate as appropriate, with an s.a.e., within 5 days.
14. Objections must be made within 30 minutes, in writing, with a £10 fee.
15. The Chief Steward reserves the right to prevent any competitor from riding the cross country phase if he or she feels that there will be a serious threat to the competitor's safety.
16. Dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
17. Competitors must wear medical armbands & body protectors for x.c.
