Conditions and Rules

- All competitors must be members of the NSEA. Details about NSEA membership can be found on their website www.nsea.co.uk
- NSEA Championship Qualifier 2012 rules will apply to this event full details can be seen on the NSEA website page Champ 2012
- When mounted all riders must wear a hard hat that conforms to BSJA or BD rules.
- The committee reserves the right to refuse an entry. No entry will be accepted without a signed consent form for each competitor.
- Excessive use of the whip and bad language will not be tolerated and the competitor will be asked to leave the premises.
- The judges decision is final.
- Entry fees will only be refunded on the production of a vet or doctor's certificate within 7 days of the event date.
- By entering to this event competitors agree to being photographed by the official photographer for use in further publicity material.

Dressage General Information

- The competition will be run under British Dressage Rules 2012 as stated in NSEA Championship Qualifier Rules.
- Teams to consist of 3 or 4 different riders and horses
- 2 riders from the team will compete in the Prelim section and the remaining 1 or 2 riders from the team will compete in the Novice section.
- Scores will be calculated on a percentage basis with the top 3 scores to count from each team.
- Each team member will automatically be entered as an individual with their score counting from their team competition.

Show Jumping General Information

- Show Jumping will be scored to BSJA rules
- Single phase competition with the jumps raised by up to 5 cm in the jump off section of the course.
- Competitors are to carry on and complete the time section of the course unless eliminated in the first section of the course.
- Teams to consist of 3 or 4 different riders and horses
- The top 3 scores from each team to count.
- Each team member will automatically be entered as an individual with their score counting from their team competition
