CLASS 1 Grass Roots. Fences max 60 cm. For novice riders any age and not to have competed in any competition over 60 cm. Riders in this class cannot compete in the Mini, Novice or Intermediate Classes. **Kindly Sponsored by Questeeze Equestrian, Farming and Country Stores**

CLASS 2 Mini. Riders to be 13 years and under on 1st Jan 2012. Fences approx 70-75 cm max. Riders in this class cannot compete in the Intermediate Class. **Kindly Sponsored by Rasen Hardware and DIY**

CLASS 3 Novice. Fences approx 80 - 85 cm max. Horse/Rider combination not to have competed in BS competitions above British Novice level. **Kindly sponsored by Faldingworth Equestrian Centre**

CLASS 4 Intermediate Fences approx 90 - 95 cm max. Horse/Rider combination not to have competed in BS competitions above Discovery level. **Kindly Sponsored by Cardsave**

TEAM PRIZES - Trophies to 1st and 2nd place and rosettes 1st – 3rd place. **INDIVIDUALS** Prizes 1st – 3rd and rosettes 1st – 6th for individuals.

ENTRIES - Only entries made on the official entry form (photocopies allowed) and accompanied by full payment will be accepted. Entries will close on Thursday 1st March 2012 and should be sent to the entries secretary **NOT** the school.

No entries will be accepted or refunds given after the close of entries.

RULES

1. All schools entering the competition are to be members of the NSEA and membership number clearly printed on entry form.
2. All classes will be open to teams of 3 / 4 (best 3 scores to count) and individuals.
3. The competition will be run under NSEA Rules 2012 and in accordance with BS Rules 2011/12. (It is the responsibility of the Team Manager of each school to ensure that their riding team knows the relevant rules).
4. Numbers in each class will be strictly limited and there will be provision for a number of individual competitors in each class. Once the limit has been reached no more entries for that class will be accepted.
5. Age as at 1st January 2012.
6. Any objections must be made to the Organiser/Secretary within 5 minutes of the end of the class in writing with a £30 deposit. Video/ photographic evidence is not admissible. If your objection is upheld your deposit will be refunded. Objections may only be made by team managers or a person appointed to act on their behalf.
7. Due to the number of entries that are expected it is essential that everyone obeys the officials and stewards at all times. There will be restrictions as to how many people may be in the warm up arena at any one time.
8. Dogs should be kept on leads at all times and owners are asked to clean up after them.
9. Competitors and spectators will be held responsible for any damage caused by their children or animals except accidental breakages of poles when competing.
10. Only the Team Manager (Team Trainer, Supporting Teacher, Riding Captain or the appointed responsible adult for that school) of each school is to deal with the secretary for declarations, enquiries, objections etc.
11. Declarations to be made 10 minutes before the start of each class, by the Team Manager only.

Neither the organisers, nor any person acting on their behalf accept any liability for any loss, damage, accident, injury or illness to horses, riders, spectators or any other persons or property whatsoever.
