1. Teams of 4 and Individual Fences approximately 2'6" – 2'9" (80cm)	09.00am
2. Teams of 4 and Individual Fences approximately 2'9" to 3' (90cm)	10.30am
3. Teams of 4 and Individual Fences approximately 3' to 3'3" (1m)	12.30pm
4. Teams of 4 and Individual Fences approximately 3'3" to 3'6" (1.05m)	2.30pm
5. Individual Fences approximately 3'6" to 3'9" (1.10m)	4.30 pm

- All classes will be run as a BSJA Single Phase Competition (course in two parts with second part timed. Competitor to jump both parts unless eliminated. Three refusals, instead of two refusals will result in elimination). Faults to be accumulated.
- All team members will automatically compete for individual prizes as well.
- Classes will run as teams first then individuals. Running order will be available on www.headington.org on or before April 9th. Competitors are responsible to be ready to compete when called.
- Teams to be comprised of 4 riders – best 3 scores to count.
- Entry fee: £16/round.
- Competition not suggested for beginners.
- Course to be built by Addington BSJA course designer. **Courses will be up to height.**
- Course walk at the beginning of each class.
- Please read the rules carefully and make sure every competitor has a copy.

Entry Fees: £16 per horse per class. Teams consist of 4 individuals.
(Entries in a team gives automatic entry as an individual)

RUN UNDER NSEA, BSJA & THE FOLLOWING RULES

1. All competitors must be full-time students of school represented. All schools must be current NSEA members. Please quote NSEA number on entry form.
2. Horses may not compete in the same class more than once.
3. Riders may compete on a maximum of two horses. Riders may not compete more than twice in the same class.
4. Horses may compete in a maximum of two classes.
5. A rider may only compete once in any team, therefore cannot compete two horses in the same team.
6. The ruling of the judge is final. Objections must be made by the Team Manager only, within 5 minutes of the end of the class in writing with a £30 deposit. Video/photographic evidence is not admissible.
7. In all cases, the term "horse" is used to imply horse or pony. This competition is open to horses of all sizes but they must not be under 4 years of age. No horses may be led.
8. All competitors must be suitably dressed in correct riding attire and hats approved to PAS 015:1998, EN1384:1996, BSEN 1384:1997 with BSI Kitemark, Snell E2001 with official Snell label and number, AS/NZS 3838:1998 or the AS/NZS 3838:2003 standards shall be worn correctly fastened at all times when mounted. It is strongly recommended that body protectors are worn when jumping.
9. All entries to be made on official entry forms and returned to Mrs. P. Ambrose with entry fees by closing date. Entries will be limited and will close on 2nd April 2012 or when classes full. **First come, first served basis**. No late entries – substitutions may be accepted at Organiser's discretion.
10. The results of this competition counts towards the NSEA County Competition for schools in the Buckinghamshire area (please state on entry form if eligible) and the Central Regional points scheme.
11. No dogs permitted beyond lorry park.
12. No liability shall fall on the Organisers, Landowners, Judges, Officials, Pony Club or Headington School in respect of any loss, damage or injury howsoever caused and all competitors are deemed to be liable to indemnify the said persons in respect of any such loss, damage or injury. The organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the Health and Safety of everyone present. Everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring, and must obey the instructions of all officials, stewards and organisers.
13. The organizers reserve the right to cancel the event in which case the entry fees will be refunded less an administrative fee upon receipt of a request and a stamped, self-addressed envelope.
14. Management and organizers reserve the right to refuse service to anyone who is not friendly. Poorly mannered horses, children, or adults may be asked to leave without prior notice.
15. For avoidance of doubt, rules to apply will largely follow BSJA although three refusals instead of two refusals result in elimination. NSEA Generic Rules 2012 will also apply. (see website www.nsea.co.uk)
