Entries close Sunday 18th March 2012

The Competition will be run as a single phase competition under BS Rules

Team competition – Teams of 3 or 4, best three scores to count

- Class 1 The Tractor Ted Warm Up 65cm**
(Individual entries only no teams)
- Class 2 The SP Broadway Mini NSEA Qualifier 70cm**
(Team and Individual entries)
- Class 3 The Marlborough International Horse Transport Novice NSEA Qualifier 80cm** (Team and Individual entries)
- Class 4 The PostSpanner Intermediate NSEA Qualifier 90cm**(Team and Individual entries)
- Class5 The DWC Turf Open NSEA Qualifier 1.00m** (Team and Individual entries)
- Class 6 The Outside Chance Advanced NSEA Qualifier 1.10m**(Individual entries)

£45 per team, £12 per individual. Cheques made payable to Pinewood School Ltd.

Each class will have rosettes to 8th place. The first 2 teams and 2 individuals in classes 2, 3, 4, and 5 and the first 2 individuals in class 6 qualify for the NSEA Championships to be held in November 2012.

HATS MUST CONFORM TO BS RULES AND BACK PROTECTORS ARE RECOMMENDED.

ENTRIES CLOSE ON Sunday 18th March 2012. In the event of oversubscription, a ballot will be drawn on Monday 19th March 2012.

All schools to be members of the NSEA and provide the secretary with their membership number on the entry form. Only the Team Manager (Team Trainer, Supporting Teacher, Riding Captain or the appointed responsible adult for that school) of each school is to deal with the Secretary. (For declarations, enquiries, objections etc.). This should be the person/s listed on the NSEA Membership Form. (Further Team Managers can be emailed to us at a later date). Objections must be made by the Team Manager only, within 5 minutes of the end of the class, in writing, with a £30 deposit. Video/photographic evidence is not admissible.

RIDERS

Riders must be in full time education at the school/ college they represent in 2012. (Age u19 on 1st Jan 2012)

A rider may only compete once in any team, therefore cannot compete two horses in the same team.

A rider may not compete in both mini and open classes.

For **minimus 65cm and mini 70 cms** competitions, the age of rider must be 13yrs & under on 1st Jan 2012.(except Grass Roots Competitions)

There will be no refunds after the close of entry without a vet or doctors certificate

In the event of cancellation of the event £2 per rider will be retained for admin costs

The organiser may, at her discretion, alter the schedule/rules as required

HORSES

Any horse competing at 1m(1.05m) may not also compete in the 70cm class at the same competition. FEI Pony/ JRN horse/rider combinations are not eligible to compete in any 80cm classes.

No horse may be ridden by two different riders in the same class except in NSEA Grass Roots Competitions.

A competitor in Grass Roots Competitions cannot have successfully completed in NSEA 80cm classes or above.

At a grass roots competition, the 70cm (mini) class can be open to riders up to the age of 18yrs.

GENERAL RULES

for SHOW JUMPING, DRESSAGE AND ARENA EVENTING (JwS)

RULES FOR THE QUALIFYING ROUNDS & CHAMPIONSHIPS

9. Balloting. If entries at regional qualifiers are over subscribed, balloting will take place in the following order :

out of area teams, second & subsequent teams, individual second rides

10. The first 2 teams and 2 individuals will qualify for the Championships. If they are unable to go to the Championships or have already qualified, the qualification will be passed down the line on the day (this can be offered down as far as 6th place at the judge's discretion.)

11. A school may qualify 2 teams for the Championships per class, but may only qualify 1 team per class per competition. No school sashes to be worn at prize giving (sponsors request).

12. Should a school have two teams placed in the top 2 in a qualifying class, the next placed team down the line may qualify for the Championships, at the judge's discretion, (3rd place) or if any of the first 2 teams have already qualified 2 teams.

13. Each team at the Championships must include two out of the original qualified four horse/rider combinations. A Team Manager may then have up to 2 wild card substitutions providing they fulfil the following criteria;

a) The horse/rider combination must have successfully completed a NSEA Competition throughout the same year and an NSEA, B.E or BSJA competition at the same level.

b) A team may qualify with a team of only 3 riders, then take a fourth as 1 wild card, providing they fulfil the above criteria (see a)

c) If a team rider is eliminated at a qualifier and their team goes on to qualify, they may not compete at the Championships unless they complete at another NSEA competition, at the same level or above and their entry is sent with an authorising letter from their Team Manager.

14. Objections must be made by the Team Manager only, within 5 minutes of the end of the class, in writing, with a £30 deposit. Video/photographic evidence is not admissible.

15. Only the Team Manager (Team Trainer, Supporting Teacher, Riding Captain or the appointed responsible adult for that school) of each school is to deal with the Secretary. (for declarations, enquiries, objections etc)

16. Declarations to be made 10 minutes before the start of each class, by the Team Manager.

17. For confirmation of entries at qualifiers, please check individual websites. For the Championships, please check the NSEA website. If you do not wish for your child's name to be posted on the website, please write on your entry form and confirm with the secretary.

18. At the Championships, the height of the fences shall be raised 5cms from the qualifying height.

19. RIDERS

i) All riders must be in full time education at the school or college they represent in 2010 (age U19 on 1st Jan 2010)

ii) If a rider qualifies for one school, then changes school, they should ride in the final for the original school, unless the second school also qualifies. The rider may only compete for 1 school at the final.

iii) A rider may not compete in both mini and open classes.

iv) If a rider (age 13 & under 1st Jan 2010) starts the year as a mini, qualifies at mini then progresses and qualifies later in the year at open height on any horse, they will automatically forfeit their mini qualification.

v) Combinations of horse and rider may only compete in 2 teams per qualifier.

vi) A rider may only compete once in any team, therefore cannot compete two horses in the same team.

vii) If a rider wins an individual class at the Championship, they may compete in a team at a lower height the following year, but are unable to qualify individually for any height lower than the one they won at.

20. HORSES

a) A horse may only compete in two classes at each qualifier, once in each class & height.

b) Any horse competing at 1m-1.05m may not also compete in the 70cm class.

c) No horse may be ridden by two different riders in the same class.

d) Horses to be plaited at the Championships.

e) No horse may compete twice in the same class at a qualifier or the Championships.
