ALL SCHOOLS MUST BE NSEA MEMBERS AND PROVIDE THEIR MEMBERSHIP NUMBER ON THE ENTRY FORM.

- Teams of 3, all scores to count.
- Team riders may compete in any class to make up their team.  
EG. 3 x Class 1, 2 or 3 or 1 in one class, 2 in another or one in each class.
- Each team rider will also be counted, automatically, as an individual.
- Individual entries will also be accepted.
- Combination of horse and rider to compete once only as a team member.
- A rider may compete in up to two teams providing they're riding two different horses.
- Each school may enter as many teams as they wish.
- Entry fee: £12.00 per combination, per class.
- Cheques made payable to: E. Baldwin
- Entries close: Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup> February or earlier if classes are full.

## NSEA GENERAL RULES 2012

### Teams

T1) All riders to be from the same school.

### Riders

R1) Riders must be in full time education at the school/college they represent in 2012.  
(aged under 19 on 1st Jan 2012)

R2) Riders who are home schooled may only compete as individuals (unless there are a number of riders from one family or are educated as a home schooled group)

R3) A rider may only compete once in any team, therefore cannot compete two horses in the same team.

R4) A rider may not compete in both mini and open classes.

\*R5) For **MINI/70cm** competitions, the age of rider must be 13yrs & under on 1st Jan 2012.  
(except Grass Roots Competitions)

R6) Boys & girls compete in the same classes.

### Points Leagues

P1) The location of the school is irrelevant, teams can accrue points at any competition listed on the NSEA website but, the points gained, will be applied to the league table for the region in which they were gained. That is, points gained at a competition held in one region, for example North East, cannot be used in the points league of another region, for example South West.

P2) Individual points leagues will run in areas where there is a demand for them. We are currently running an individual points league in the North East region.

P3) For the Individual Points league, the combination of horse & rider will accrue points. Therefore, if a rider competes on more than one horse, they will gain points on each horse separately in the relevant league table.

P4) If you do not wish your child's name to appear in the results, you must contact us immediately.

## **SPECIFIC RULES**

(Scoring, tack etc unless otherwise stated on the schedule)

### **Dressage – British Dressage Rules 2012**

#### **Conditions of entry**

In order to compete in events listed on the NSEA website, all competing schools must now be members of the NSEA, and show their membership number on entry forms. For full details of how to join go to [www.nsea.co.uk](http://www.nsea.co.uk)

Entries must be made in advance, late entries to be accepted at the discretion of the organisers.

The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry, for any reason.

Competitors must wear correct clothing and tack in accordance with BD rules.

Lungeing is not permitted in any working area.

The decision of the judges is final.

Children under 16 must be supervised at all times.

All riders **MUST** wear hard hats, correctly fitting and to the latest BSI specifications according to the rules with the chin strap done up whilst mounted. All dressage hats must have a fitted chin strap.

Any objections must be made to the organiser within 5 minutes of the completion of the event, in writing, accompanied by a deposit of £30 which may be forfeited if the objection is overruled.

The organisers shall not be liable for any claims in respect of damage or accident to any person, whether competitor, servant or spectator, horse, vehicle or property, howsoever caused in conjunction with or arising out of the show.

### **DIRECTIONS**

Sandhurst Farm is situated two miles north of Lamberhurst, just off the A21.  
**Postcode TN3 8AX**

From the A21 approach southbound from the Kippings Cross roundabout (M & S garage) as the turning is too tight if you approach going north.

If approaching from the south (Lamberhurst), it is best to go up to the roundabout (M & S garage) and turn back down the A21.

Turn right off the A21 into Clayhill Road, which is also signed to Hook Green (there is a small farm shop on the right, just before the turning).

Sandhurst Farm is the first turning on the right, down a concrete drive. Please observe the traffic lights. The drive is very steep so please drive slowly using a low gear.

Follow the drive down to the bottom of the hill. At the end of the main drive, as you approach the house, follow the road around to the right and then shortly after that, do not drive into the stable yard but follow the road around to the left and down over a bridge. You will then see the dressage arena & indoor school.
