

Rules and Conditions

- All classes to be run under BS and NSEA General Rules 2012
- All team entries close 28TH MARCH 12. Entries may be limited. Entries for individuals on the day if space available, £2 extra. And prepared to jump first.
- Competitors representing a school must be in full time education at that school, on the date of competition, and under 19 years of age
- When mounted, all riders must wear a hat that conforms to pony club/Baja rules
- The decision of the judge is final.

- The Organizers have the right to cancel, amend or add to classes.

- Please obey all Golden Cross equestrian Centre's rules; these are a requirement by law for Health and Safety.

- Cars to be parked in the car park, not the lorry park. Vehicles parked in the lorry park must be parked front end first.

- No horse or pony to be tied to an unhitched trailer, or left unattended.

- Objections to be made to the Secretary in writing within 20 minutes of dispute, with a deposit of £10.

- The Organizers or persons acting on their behalf do not accept liability for loss; damage accident or injury however caused arising out of or connected with this competition. It shall be considered a condition of entry that each entrant agrees to these rules.

RIDERS

All riders must be in full time education at the school or college they represent in 2010. (Age U19 on 1st Jan 2011), and be Members of the NSEA

A rider may not compete in both mini and open classes.

Combinations of horse and rider may only compete in 2 classes

A rider may only compete once in any team, therefore cannot compete two horses in the same team.

SINGLE PHASE

CLASS 1 60cm - GRASS ROOTS TEAMS/ INDIV

CLASS 2 70cm - MINI TEAMS / INDIV

CLASS 3 80cm- NOVICE TEAMS / INDIV

CLASS 4 90cm - INTERMEDIATE TEAMS / INDIV

Course Builder: T.B.C

Entry fee. £32 per team, £9 per individual

Rosettes to 8th --- TEAMS and INDIVIDUALS

ALSO OPEN TO INDIVIDUAL ENTRIES IN EACH CLASS

All classes will be run as a BSJA Single Phase Competition a course in two parts with second part timed. All will jump against the clock immediately after their first, even with faults unless eliminated.

All team members will automatically compete for individual prizes as well.

Teams may consist of three or four riders from the same school.

Competitors will be awarded Show Jumping League points based on a points system.

(1st =6pts, 2nd= 5pts...6th= 1pt).

Best 3 scores to count in the team competition.

HORSES

A horse may only compete in two classes at each once in each class & height.

Any horse competing at 90CM may not compete in the 60cm class.

No horse may be ridden by two different riders in the same class.

Balloting. If entries are over oversubscribed, balloting will take place in the following order

: Out of area teams, second & subsequent teams, individual second rides,
